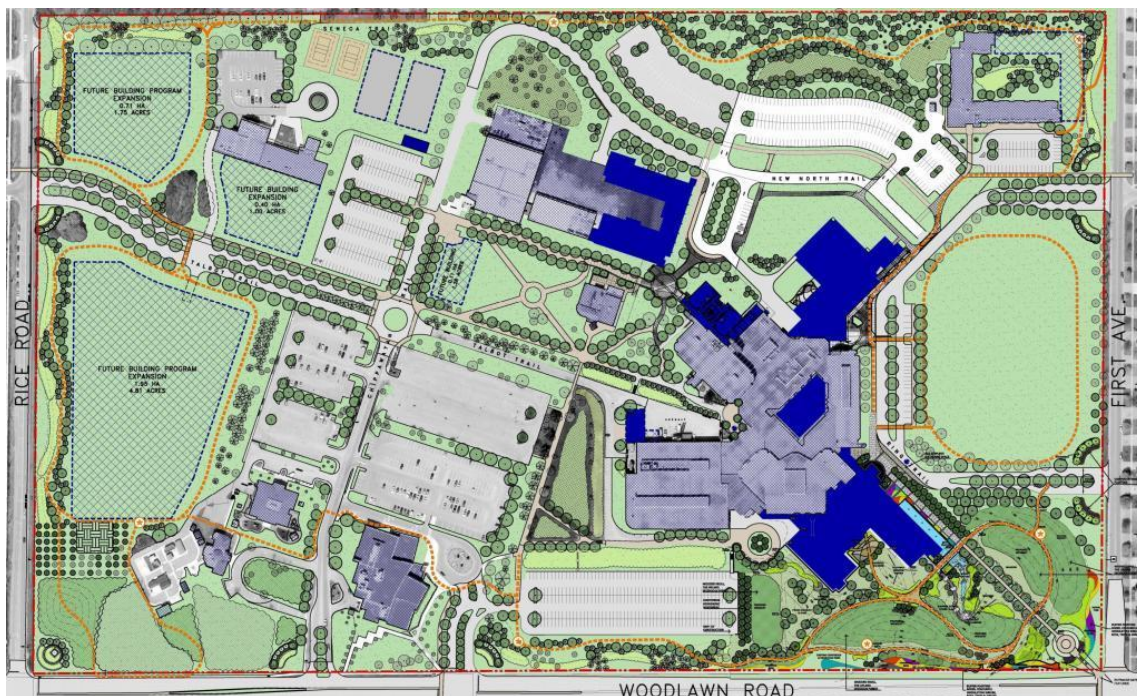


Yellow roofs indicate existing buildings on the 100-acre Welland Campus
